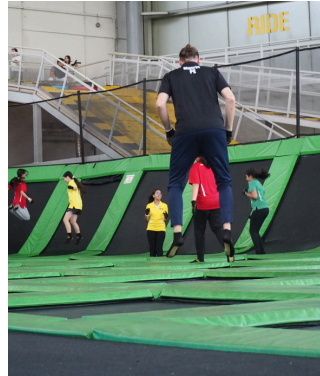

100 Days of School Event

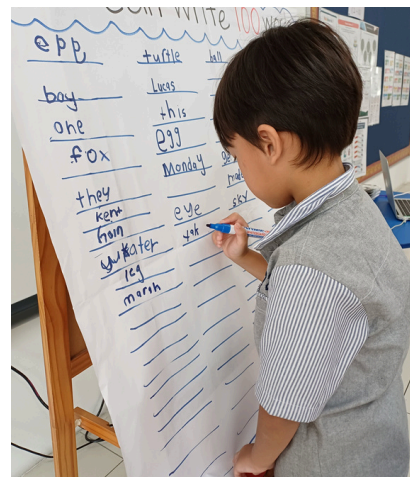
