# Understanding INTERNATIONAL

PRIMARY CURRICULUM



## What is the International Primary Curriculum (IPC)?

The IPC is one of the fastest-growing curriculum choices in the world today. It is currently used by more than 2,000 schools in more than 90 countries. It has grown in popularity among international schools because the curriculum helps develop children from 5 to 12-years old academically, personally and internationally.

## How does a student learn through the IPC?

Thematic learning, learning through themes, is how we teach students using the IPC. Each year group is given a different theme every half-term or a term (as some last longer than others). Some themes we cover in Matrix International School are food, electricity, living things, the things people do and rivers. Through each theme, students will learn about different subjects.

The IPC is made up of ten main subjects: Art, Geography, History, ICT & Computing, International, Music, Physical Education, Science, Society and Technology.

Not all subjects will be covered through each theme but we have carefully chosen them to ensure students achieve all that they are supposed to have learned in each subject over a two-year period (known as a Milepost).

For every subject, students will have different research and recording tasks they need to complete. The research tasks allow the students to gather information on the theme and the recording tasks allow them to express what they have learned.

As no child learns in exactly the same way, we try to provide a variety of experiences and opportunities for the students to research and record information. Some of the ways that we do it in Matrix International School are:

## How are parents updated regarding their child's learning?

We update parents on what their child is learning in Matrix International School by:

- 1) sending an overview of all the IPC topics for the year on the ENGAGE Parent Portal.
- sending a termly overview (for all subjects) at the beginning of each term on the ENGAGE Parent Portal.
- 3) sending home an IPC circular at the beginning of each IPC unit.
- using Google Sites (http://bit.ly/MISlearning) to give weekly updates on what your child has been learning in the classroom.
- 5) providing specific information on their performance during termly Parent Teacher Conferences (PTC).
